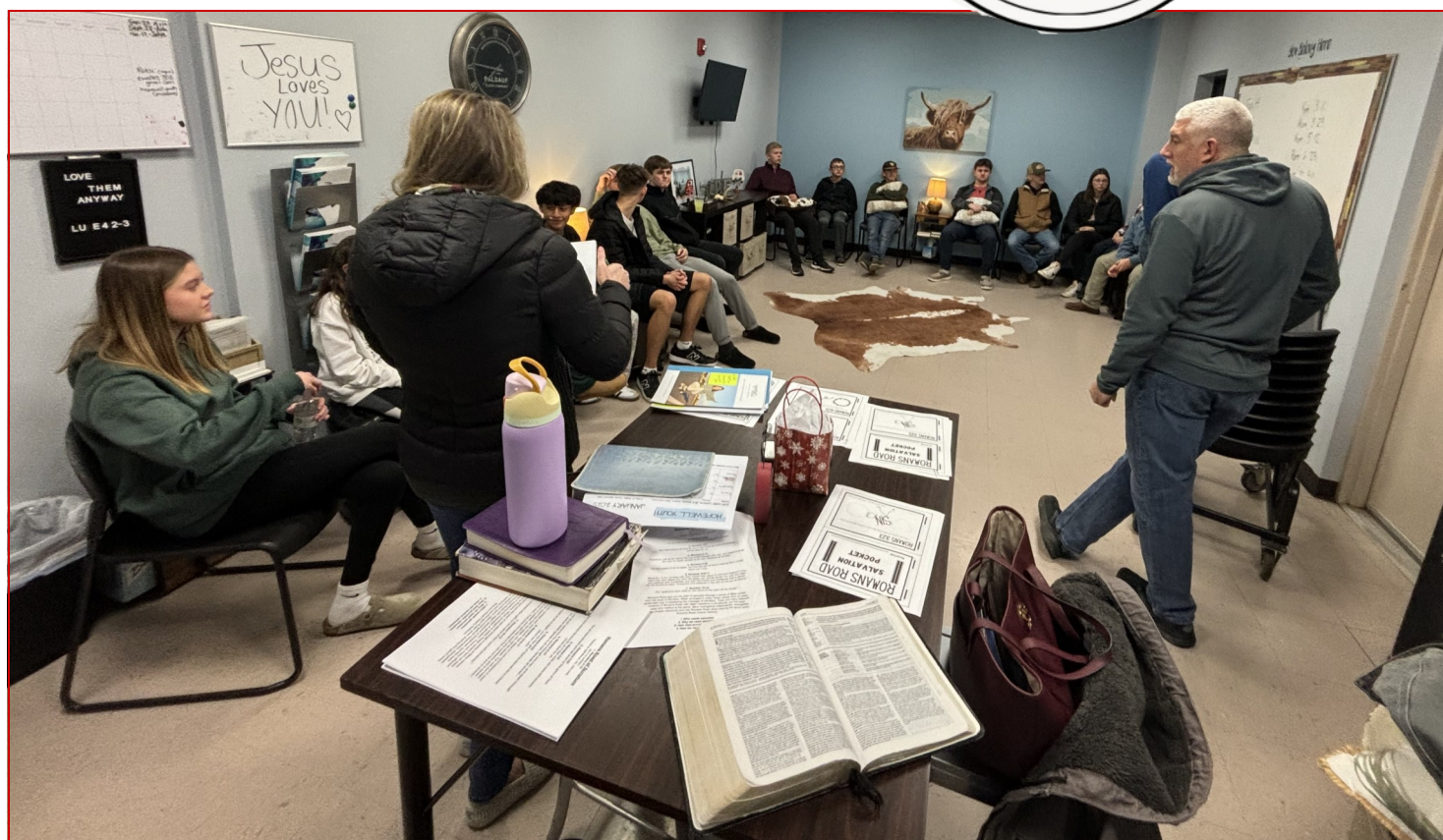
JOIN THE YOUTH GROUP

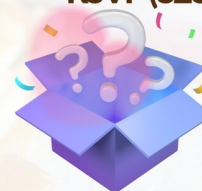
