“Wherever He may

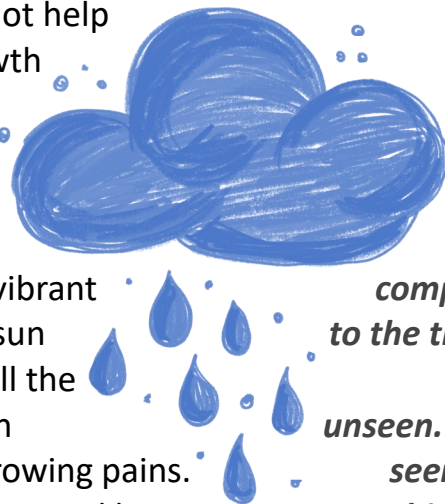

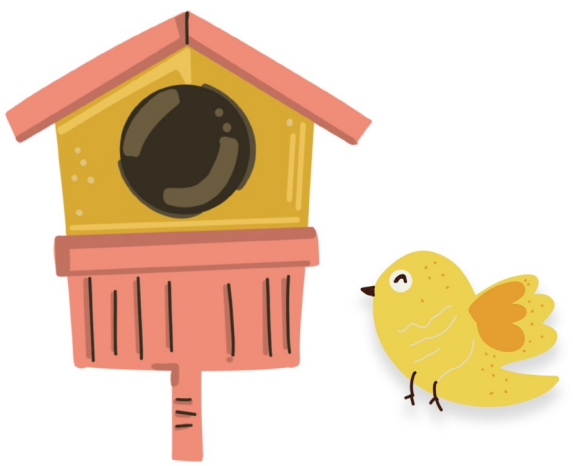

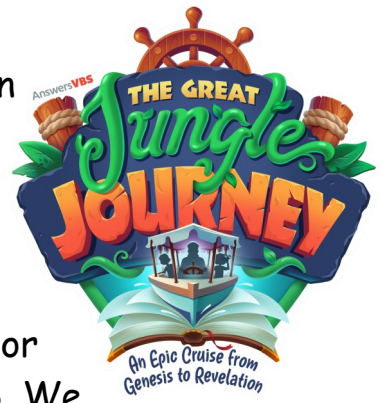


Happy Spring!
